Jack Gibbons

plays the Authentic

George Gershwin

Acknowledged as one of the world's leading exponents of Gershwin's music, renowned British pianist Jack Gibbons returns to New York's Lincoln Center following tremendous standing ovations at his sold-out perform-

ance in 1997. His all-Gershwin program brings together a stunning collection of show tunes and concert works — highlighting all facets of Gershwin's genius — and includes Gibbons' unique recreations of Gershwin's original improvisations, meticulously reconstructed note for note from Gershwin's own recordings. Many of these arrangements have not been played in New York since Gershwin's performances in the 1920's and 30's

Public performer from the age of 10, and winner at 20 of the Newport International Piano Competition, Jack Gibbons has performed to standing ovations in leading concert halls around the world. His highly popular all-Gershwin concerts at London's prestigious Queen Elizabeth Hall have been an annual event since 1990. In August 1995, he was invited by the BBC to perform *Rhapsody in Blue* for the Centenary season of the BBC Promenade Concerts at London's Royal Albert Hall, on which occasion he was hailed by the BBC as "THE Gershwin pianist of our time."

Jack Gibbons is also recognized as an entertaining and informative communicator. He has broadcast extensively in the UK, the USA, Europe, Australia and the Middle East. For the Gershwin Centenary, Gibbons wrote and presented a special BBC feature program entitled "Gershwin in Focus" with Oscar-winning actor Ben Kingsley as the voice of George Gershwin.

Gibbons' recreation of Gershwin's legendary piano style has drawn praise from musicians and critics on both sides of the Atlantic. Edward Jablonski, eminent Gershwin biographer and long-time friend of the Gershwin family, describes Gibbons' performances as "exciting and uncanny . . . a remarkable recreation of Gershwin's unique keyboard style." Gibbons' recreations are now the subject of an award-winning CD series, "The Authentic George Gershwin," recently acclaimed by Classic CD Magazine as "a unique testimony to Gershwin's genius."
